South Africa - Safari Packing List

Hunting Clothing:

- · (2) hunting shorts (for summer months).
- · (2) hunting pants (tough enough for thick brush and thorns recommended).
- · (3-4) pairs hunting/hiking socks.
- · (3-4) pairs underwear.
- · (2) pairs long underwear (for winter months).
- · (1) hunting boots (recommend Courtney Selous).
- (1) boot gaiters.
- · (1) camp shoes.
- · (2-3) hunting t-shirts.
- · (2-3) long sleeve hunting shirts.
- · (1) hunting vest.
- (1) mid-layer hunting jacket like a hooded sweatshirt or fleece.
- (1) outer-layer hunting jacket (soft shell layer that can cut the wind on the truck rides).
- · (1) stocking cap/beanie (for winter months).
- (1) neck gaiter/buff (good for cold mornings, to keep dust out of your nose on truck rides, and sun protection on neck and face...in summer months the lightweight fishing style with SPF work well. Merino wool neck gaiters best for winter months).
- (1) baseball cap or safari hat.
- · (1) sunglasses polarized.
- (1) leather gloves (fleece lined for winter months).
- (1) leather belt.

Note: we have daily laundry so you can pack light....2-3 days' worth of changes.

Essentials:

- · Chap stick (bring a few sticks the desert will dry your lips out).
- · Fingernail clippers.
- Tweezers.
- · Saline nose rinse...it is the desert so dust can get in your nose!
- Sunblock.





- Face lotion w/aloe for wind and sunburns.
- · Cue tips.
- · Visine eye drops (in case you get dust or something in your eye in the field).
- · Power converter and charging cables.
- · Travel coffee mug (if you want to drink coffee without spilling on the truck rides).

Gun/optics related:

- · Rifle and good rifle sling.
- · Suppressor for rifle if you have one.
- 80 rounds of ammo.
- Bore snake (to get dust and debris out of your gun barrel and action from truck rides and stalks.)
- · Travel size gun oil wipes and cleaner.
- Lens wipes.
- · Binoculars 8-10 power. Built in rangefinder is handy.
- · Bino harness or case.
- · Soft gun case.

Other hunting gear:

- Day pack.
- Shooting sticks (we have them if you don't want to bring your own).
- Pocket knife.
- · Ammo belt or ammo pouch/case.
- · Hearing protection.

Other misc. toiletries/medicine:

- · Pain reliever.
- · Antacid (Tums).
- Vitamins.
- · Toothpaste.
- · Toothbrush.
- Deodorant.
- · Razer and shaving cream.
- · Allergy medicine...it is dusty in the desert so nose spray at minimal even if just saline is helpful.



Any prescription medicines.

Note: We will provide soap, shampoo, conditioner, body lotion, hand soap, towels, and do laundry every day so there is no need to bring these items.

Other considerations:

- · Vaccinations all up to date.
- · Travel insurance/medical evacuation insurance recommended.
- · Rifle import permits.
- Cash for tips...highly suggest envelopes or thank you cards to help you easily organize gratuities to hand out at the conclusion of the trip. There will be trackers, skinners, drivers, housekeepers, chef and your PH assisting you on the trip.
